Again, there is no evidence of osteopenia or osteoporosis at any tested site in the lumbar spine.	
IMPRESSION: There is no DEXA scan for comparison. Bone density in the femur region is within normal limits. No evidence of osteopenia or osteoporosis in the lumbar spine.
